


Zodiac Child





The Moon is in Libra



Venus is in Virgo



The Sun in the Horoscope

The Sun represents your child's identity. It describes your child's basic personality traits and their talents. It is the centre of a child's self-expression. The Sun can also tell us about a child's father.

The Sun is in Leo




Mercury in the Horoscope

The planet Mercury describes your children's intellectual abilities. The sign and placement of Mercury can describe whether or not your child finds it easy to concentrate at school. Either way it is possible to boost your child's self-esteem by choosing study methods and schooling that suits their needs rather than forcing them to fit into an alien environment. 
The Ascendant


Mars in the Horoscope


Mars is in the 5th House

Neither is it possible for us to isolate one part of a birth chart. The different aspects of our children's birth charts intermingle in a complex manner to make the little person that we know and love. However, it is possible for us to influence the development of our children, to support them in their journey. The aim of this section is to give vital clues for parents and mentors on how to guide, but not coerce, the development of your child.


Jupiter is Sextile The Moon

Georgia is an amiable baby and a co-operative child. She finds pleasure in her relationship with her parents, in particular her mother or another mother figure in her young life. As a result young Georgia is socially secure and feels that the world is a bountiful place. Georgia enjoys pleasing other people, especially important women in her life. In return Georgia receives much affection and many favours from mother or other significant women. Georgia's optimistic outlook on life also attracts positive attention from other people. Social occasions are a joy with popular young Georgia around. Friends and family members enjoy bestowing gifts. All in all life is pretty good for young Georgia.

Georgia is also likely to find emotional satisfaction from learning. As a result, she is self-motivated when it comes to her school work. This, of course, depends on other aspects of Georgia's birth chart. However, it is likely that Georgia finds life rewarding, passing with ease through each new stage of childhood with very little effort on the part of her parents.

Mars is Square The Moon

The combination of the planet Mars and the Moon is fiery and emotional. Young Georgia is likely to have plenty of energy and determination from a young age. A lively child, she delights in exploring new activities. She is independent and does not need the company of other children to keep her amused. Georgia benefits most when independence is encouraged. She needs freedom within safe boundaries. Georgia also needs to be encouraged to express her emotions in an appropriate manner.

Georgia enjoys activities which provide an outlet for her abundant energy. Individual sports, outdoor games or martial arts may be of benefit.

Uranus is Opposite The Moon

Change is likely to play a prominent role in young Georgia's life. Parents and family members may try to provide a set routine for baby Georgia, but the routine is destined to be unsettled. This could be due to positive changes in Georgia's home life or because of upsets in her early life. Georgia's birth may have coincided with problems in her mother's life or perhaps her mother is a free spirit. In some cases Georgia's family or mother may have an unusual occupation or lifestyle. Depending on other aspects of Georgia's chart, she either enjoys the stimulation of a changing environment, or is unsettled by the lack of routine. Either way Georgia has the opportunity to develop as a resourceful, inventive and independent person. As a young child she may experience sudden mood changes as she learns to come to terms with life's challenges.

Parents do well to encourage Georgia's unique talents, and try to discipline through creative means rather than traditional ones because it is likely that Georgia is a non-conformist. Neptune is Sesquisquare The Moon


Georgia is a soft, imaginative and sensitive child. She needs gentle handling and a calm environment in order to thrive. Baby Georgia benefits from a peaceful and quiet home. If Georgia has noisy siblings, then she benefits from her own quiet room somewhere, to escape the hustle and bustle of daily life. This child is prone to moodiness and is sensitive to the emotional undercurrents of her household. As a result Georgia may enjoy pursuing an absorbing hobby, a creative pursuit, visiting nature, or escaping into the realm of books or movies.



Music could be soothing at moments when Georgia seems like a troubled child. In fact lullabies are likely to be the best method of getting baby Georgia off to sleep and continue to sooth Georgia throughout her life. Georgia is particularly sensitive to the influence of one woman. This could be mother or grandmother, or a favourite aunt, teacher, nanny or caregiver. This woman is likely to be idealised by Georgia and may have difficulty living up to her expectations. To offset this tendency any significant female caretaker is advised to spend as much time as possible taking part in artistic, creative or imaginative pursuits with young Georgia. Saturn is Trine The Sun

Or perhaps he is simply a disciplinarian with difficulty expressing the love that is in his heart. Either way Georgia is likely to feel limited in her self-expression as a child,



particularly before the age of 14. As a result her self-esteem could suffer. She may be a serious and somewhat shy child. It is important that Georgia's father, or father figures in her life express a lot of praise and affection to help balance the discipline. This way Georgia grows into a well-balanced young person, secure in the knowledge of her ability to achieve her goals with the support of important men in her life. She will have the self-discipline to succeed. In some cases problems can be experienced early in life because of Georgia's relationship with her father. In some cases it is not Georgia's father

that takes this stern role, but another adult male in her life. Therefore all of the above would apply to this man, not her father. It is also possible that problems can be experienced early in life because of Georgia's relationship with her father or a father figure. If this is the case then it is likely that Georgia will face these challenges, grow in wisdom and achieve success later in life, particularly from the age of 29 years.

Saturn is Trine Mercury

Now here's a child who needs a lot of approval and support, particularly from her father or an important male mentor. The more love and kindness that Georgia receives, the more she is able to express herself in her daily life with confidence. The reason for this is that the combination of the planets Saturn and Mercury can be a difficult one, presenting some pitfalls in early childhood development. In other words young Georgia may face difficulties in her ability to learn and communicate. This, in turn, affects her self-confidence.

Georgia may be shy, preferring the safety of her home rather than venturing out and about. Georgia could be slow to talk and read. Perhaps school seems a bit overwhelming to young Georgia. She prefers to spend time reading in her own room rather than socialising with her friends. Georgia is sensitive to criticism, particularly any harsh words from her father or a prominent male member of the family. On the other hand Georgia slowly blossoms when praised by her father. She also responds well to a male mentor's patient words of wisdom.



Georgia needs a slow, methodical approach when being given any instructions. She works better within a structured environment. With calm handling Georgia gradually gains self-understanding and a wisdom that is beyond her years. Another positive note that is most of Georgia's learning difficulties are experienced in her early youth. As she matures, social and communication skills and study becomes easier.

It is almost as if Georgia is born with a greater intelligence that needs to be carefully nurtured during childhood in order for it to be fully expressed as she matures.

As Georgia grows older, she is likely to excel in specialised subject of her choice. Her selection of topic depends on other aspects of her birth chart. Parents need to make sure that Georgia is able to choose her own study topics as much as is possible. Excessive parental control could have a detrimental effect, eroding Georgia's budding self-confidence. 
